in favor of Accessible Tourism for All »**

The World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) has recently published an important document that invites the international tourism community to bring attention to the disabled market.

The recommendations by UNWTO on accessible tourism cover the following subjects:

- A. Tourism destination management
- B. Tourism information and advertising
- C. Urban and architectural environments
- D. Modes of transport and stations
- E. Accommodation, food services and conventions
- F. Cultural activities
- G. Other tourism activities and events

The new version of the publication adopted in November 2013 was written in support by ONCE Foundation and the European Network of Accessible Tourism (ENAT).
